Here's what Supplemental Instruction can do for you...

What is SI?

Supplemental Instruction (SI) are study sessions with fellow classmates lead by an experienced student who excels in the subject matter you might find difficult. The sessions are open to anyone in the class on a voluntary basis. You will learn how to study for that BIG exam, take good notes in class, and most of all “work smarter,” not just “harder.” You’ll be able to compare notes and share what you’ve learned with your peers.

What's in it for you, the student?

If you attend SI sessions regularly, chances are much higher that you will earn a better grade than if you did not attend. You will develop a better understanding of course content as well as more effective ways to learn it. This will help you to be a more successful learner in your other classes, also.

The SI Coach...

- Attends class along with students
- Is trained in the most effective learning and studying strategies
- Operates as a model student and relays tips on the most effective study skills

When does SI begin?

SI begins the 2nd week of the semester. Your SI coach will set up weekly sessions at a time most convenient to the majority of the class. The sessions are informal so you can relax, have fun and most of all, learn how to get that “A.” Consider it making your college life a lot easier.

Research shows that students can average a “full letter” grade higher as a result of attending SI sessions on a regular basis.
