The Full-Time College Transfer Program for the Full-Time Working Adult

- *Earn an average of 12 units of transfer credit each semester* by attending classes only one night a week, viewing instructional television or doing web assignments two hours a week from your home, and participating in twelve weekend conferences per semester.
- *Complete an Associate of Arts Degree in just five semesters*
- *Choose On or Off-Campus Locations*

Requirements for the PACE Program:

- Placement Assessment is required for entrance in English and Math courses.
- English 101 is highly recommended before taking the PACE courses in any of the three tracks.
- Required Mathematics courses may be taken concurrently with PACE courses.
